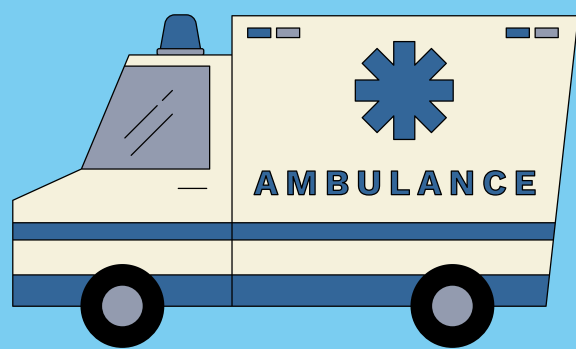


# DENIAL HANDLING IS A SYSTEMIC PROBLEM

## THE FINANCIAL DRAIN:

- \$25.7B lost in 2023 due to denied claims<sup>1</sup>
- 70% of denials are eventually overturned<sup>2</sup>
- Average appeal cost: \$57.23 per claim<sup>1</sup>



## THE CLINICAL IMPACT

- Delays in care = Worse patient outcomes
- Doctors spend 49% of their time on admin tasks<sup>3</sup>
- Denials fuel burnout and inefficiency

- Repeated errors in coding & documentation
- Lack of automation in denial management
- Only 38% of hospitals use any denial prevention tech<sup>4</sup>
